#### **What is Dark Mode**

Dark Mode is a setting on most computer operating systems that uses a dark color palette to make viewing easier on your eyes and more comfortable working in low-light environments. It is also a favorite setting in many social media apps and browsers.

Upwork has now introduced a dark mode theme for freelancers to use. Many people prefer Dark Mode, and others like me do not. But it would be best if you decided for yourself.

#### **Benefits of Dark Mode**

**Easier on the eyes:** When you find yourself in a dark room or working during the night, a brightly lit screen can strain your eyes, making them tired and dry. But fear not, Dark Mode comes to the rescue, making your screen easier on the eyes. Some people try switching for a while to rest their eyes before switching back.

**Aesthetic preferences:** Some people prefer Dark Mode because they prefer darker colors over lighter colors. Dark Mode is more aesthetically pleasing to their style.

Last month, I got a pop-up in Upwork alerting me to their new Dark Mode theme. After checking out the Community Forums I belong to, I noticed some people complained that Upwork didn't have a Dark Mode theme.

Here is a posting from one community member:

"... Upwork's bright theme can be pretty harsh on the eyes, especially during late-night work sessions. Here are a few points to consider:

Dark themes reduce eye strain and make it easier to work in low-light conditions. Upwork should definitely consider introducing a dark mode to improve user experience.

Many other popular platforms, including social media apps, video streaming services, and messaging platforms, have already introduced dark themes. Upwork could be seen as lagging behind the trend

The option to switch between light and dark themes can be a simple yet powerful feature that appeals to a wide range of users. Users who prefer a brighter theme can continue using it, while those who prefer a darker interface can switch seamlessly."


Okay, he has some valid points. However, in my opinion, all he had to do was go to the settings on his device and switch to Dark Mode—problem solved!

It turns out that many Upwork users agreed with him, to my surprise. And several that agreed with me. One Upwork user in the community forum even started yelling in his post, and this is what was said:

"I tried it for 2.5 seconds and switched back. Horribly high contrast. AND, why is Upwork spending our fees on this!!!? FIX THE \*\*bleep\*\* DESKTOP APPLICATION! Messages are always getting stuck and NOT updating! STOP WASTING TIME AND MONEY ON UNNECESSARY AND UNNEEDED FLUFF!"

Here are the top 5 freelance statistics for 2024:

- There are nearly **75 million** freelancers in the US
- Around 9 in 20 workers are self-employed
- Niger is the country with the highest proportion of self-employment (95.1%)
- The arts & design industry has the highest self-employment rate (77%)
- Gen Z is the generation most likely to freelance

As of 2024, there are an estimated **76.4 million** freelancers in the United States.
