You can now view a breakdown of each contract's impact over the past year, empowering you to manage your reputation more effectively.

### **How to Access JSS Insights:**

- 1. Log in to your freelancer account.
- 2. Click your profile icon in the upper right-hand corner.
- 3. Navigate to "Trends and Stats."
- 4. Under Job Success Score, click "View Insights."

While this transparency is invaluable, freelancers must stay vigilant, as even minor setbacks can now affect scores more immediately.


#### 2. New Cover Letter Videos
